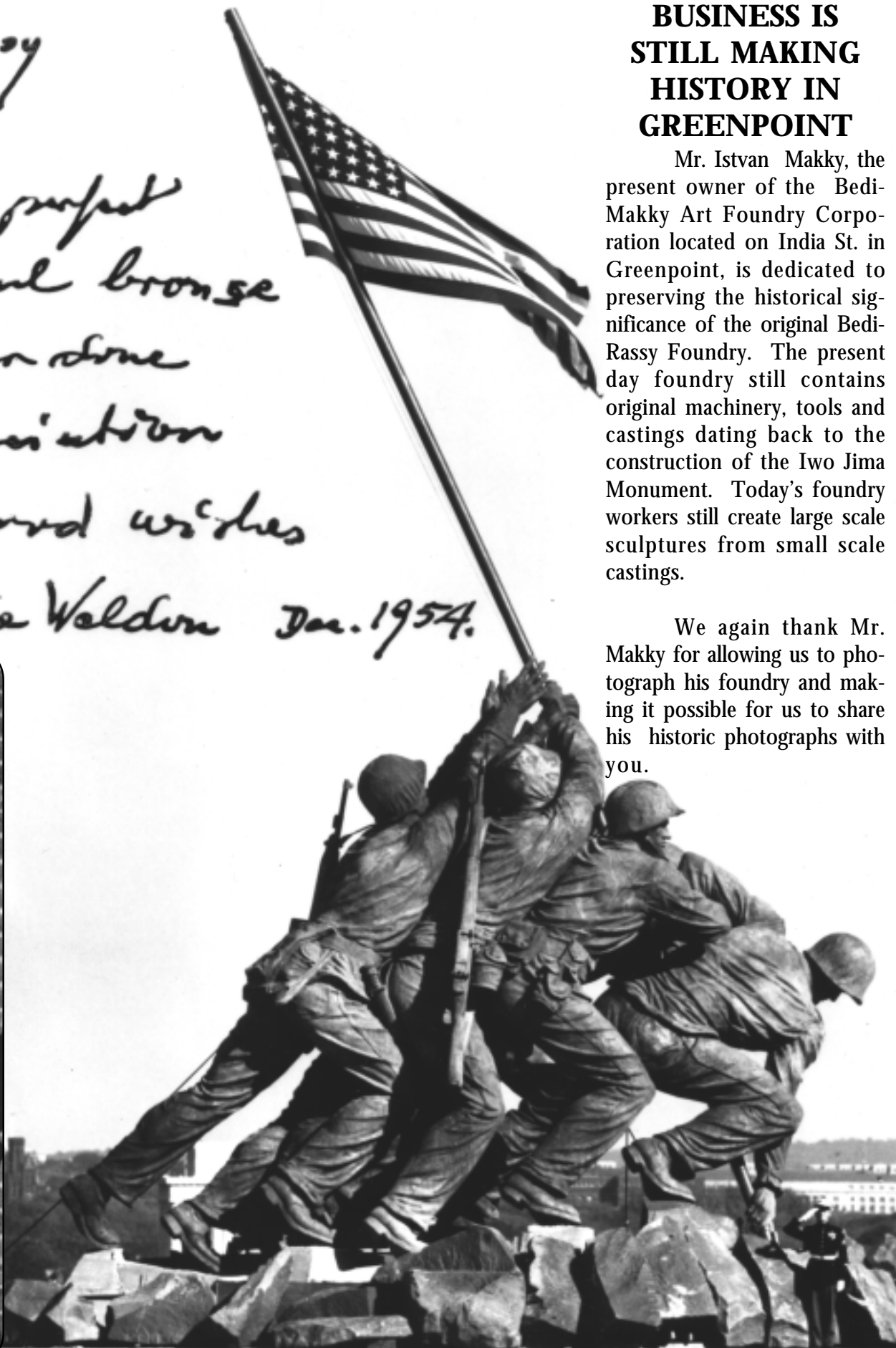


A HISTORIC BUSINESS IS STILL MAKING HISTORY IN GREENPOINT
